'DEMANDS NOT MET': ANTI-GOVERNMENT PROTESTS RESUME IN IRAQ

Protesters have gathered in Baghdads Tahrir Square to mark one year since a second wave of antigovernment protests erupted and gripped Iraq.

Iraqi security forces fired water cannon and tear gas at the protesters during Sundays demonstrations to prevent them crossing fences on a bridge leading towards government buildings.

The rallies renewed calls from early October last year, which saw the start of Iraqs biggest antigovernment protest movement since the 2003 fall of Saddam Hussein, with demonstrations in the capital Baghdad and Iraqs mainly Shia south demanding basic services, employment opportunities and an end to corruption.
