The adviser to the EUs top court has issued a recommendation to allow data protection agend any EU country to take legal action against Facebook or any other tech firm even if their req headquarters are in a different EU state.	
The recommendation was issued after Facebook sought to rebuff Belgiums privacy regulato data case by saying its European Union headquarters were in Dublin and so Ireland was the authority in the EU for the U.S. social media giant.	
Advocate-General Michal Bobek, the adviser to the Court of Justice of the European Unrecommended that the data protection agency in any EU country should be able to take action in various situations even if they were not the lead authority.
