BULGARIAN PARLIAMENT APPROVES CENTRE-RIGHT COALITION GOVERNMENT

Rosen Zhelyazkov of the GERB party was officially elected prime minister on Thursday after three months of discussion.

Bulgaria's parliament on Thursday formally approved a coalition government led by the centreright GERB party, finally installing an administration nearly three months after elections resulted in a deeply divided parliament.

Lawmakers voted 125-114 to elect Rosen Zhelyazkov, a lawyer and former speaker of parliament, as prime minister. The 56-year-old has served as minister in several previous governments. Zhelyazkov has pledged to restore financial stability and keep Bulgaria on a pro-EU and pro-NATO track.
