KYRGYZSTAN SETS DATE FOR 2027 PRESIDENTIAL ELECTION

Kyrgyz President Sadyr Japarov has submitted a draft law to parliament establishing the official date for the countrys next presidential election. The parliamentary committee on constitutional legislation has approved the proposal in all three readings.

According to the newly adopted law, the presidential election will take place on January 24, 2027, in line with amendments that designate the fourth Sunday of January as the official election date in the year the presidents term expires.

Under the current Constitution, the president of Kyrgyzstan is elected for a single six-year term, with no possibility of re-election. President Japarov was elected on January 28, 2021, and later initiated constitutional reforms, including a nationwide referendum that expanded presidential powers.
