PASHINYAN TELLS MOSCOW YEREVAN WILL NOT LEAVE EURASIAN ECONOMIC UNION

Prime Minister Nikol Pashinyan reportedly told his Russian counterpart, Mikhail Mishustin, on Thursday that Yerevan does not intend to leave the Russia-led Eurasian Economic Union.

Pashinyan and Mishutin met on the margins of a climate summit Russian Altai region of Siberia. During the meeting, the current state of Armenia-Russia relations was discussed. The sides touched upon the bilateral cooperation agenda, collaboration within the framework of the Eurasian Economic Union, as well as other issues of mutual interest, Pashinyans office said in a brief statement after the meeting.

While the readouts from both offices broadly mentioned the topic of bi-lateral relations, Russias Deputy Prime Minister Alexei Overchuk called the meeting very useful.
