
**BOOK LAUNCH: THEY TRUSTED TURKS - REFUGEES IN TURKISH TERRITORIES
THROUGHOUT HISTORY (TÜRKLERE GÜVENDİLER □ TARİH BOYUNCA TÜRK

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On 3 February 2017, Center for Eurasian Studies (AVİM) held a meeting on the book titled "They Trusted Turks - Refugees in Turkish Lands Through History" (*Türklere Güvendiler □ Tarih Boyunca Türk Topraklarına Sığınanlar*) by Ret. Ambassador Ender Arat.
